north lake tahoe variety

The selection of indoor and outdoor venues, alone, covers 30 sites and 200,000-plus square feet. From boardrooms to ballrooms, lakeside to mountainside, North Lake Tahoe facilitates productive executive sessions, association conferences, trade shows, SMERF meetings.

With 7,000 rooms, the lodging options are just as diverse – full-service resorts, hotels, inns, condominiums, bed and breakfasts. Rates cover a range of price points, and locations vary from retreat-like to town-center.

If your meeting goals include team-building, you can select from a number of possibilities, depending on your group’s interests and abilities. Attendees can get better acquainted by navigating two ropes courses, rafting the Truckee River, forming foursomes at more than a dozen golf courses, or skiing/snowboarding at 15 downhill resorts.

Somewhat lower on the adrenaline scale, you’ll find attractive group rates for paddlewheeler cruises on the lake, fishing charters, trail rides on horseback or mountain bike, and ice-skating and guided snowmobile tours. By night, there are multiple choices like live music, dancing and casino action.

Most of these activities could fill the free space in your group’s agenda, too. Attendees could also spend some on-their-own time at our sun-drenched beaches, relaxing spas, intriguing shops, museums and galleries. The list goes on with kayaking, waterskiing, snowshoeing, dogsledding...

In our fresh mountain air, an active group is a hungry group. Luckily, North Lake Tahoe’s nearly 120 eateries bring variety to the table, from hand-tossed pizza to hand-rolled sushi, American tapas to Asian Fusion, smoked gouda scramble to chocolate mousse s’more.

All of this in the spectacular scenery surrounding North America’s largest alpine lake. Camera phones in hand, your group can arrive via three international airports – Reno/Tahoe, Sacramento or San Francisco – and two interstate highways, year-round. Transportation from airport to accommodations is easy to arrange.

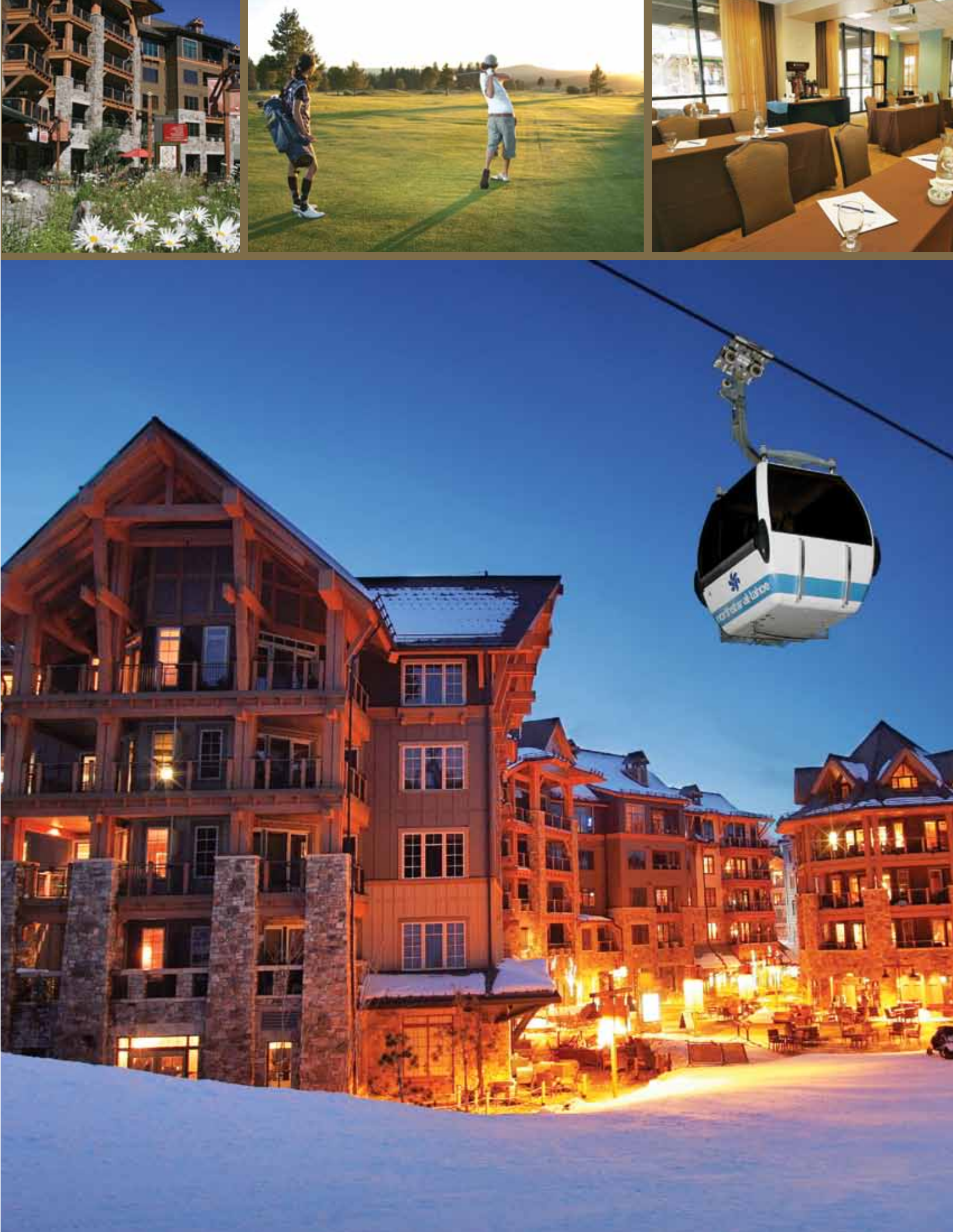

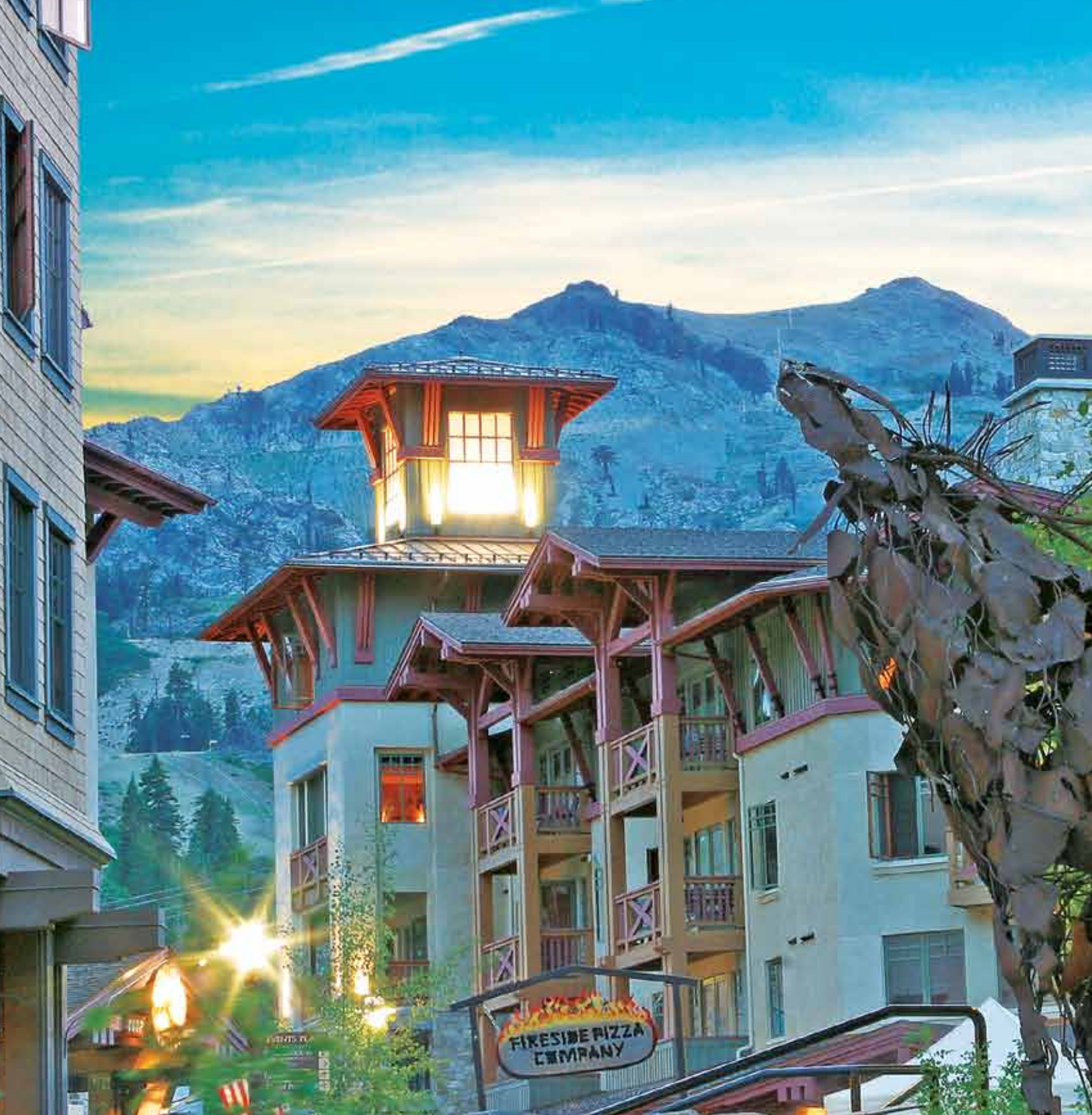

easy access

In the Air: Reno/Tahoe International is North Lake Tahoe’s main gateway only 45-minutes away, with Sacramento and San Francisco International airports also serving the area. 150 daily flights to 16 nonstop destinations and 35 same plane/one-stop destinations are available to/from many major cities. On the Ground: Two interstate highways connect North Lake Tahoe with any of the three airports year-round. Drive time is about 45 minutes from Reno, 2.5 hours from Sacramento and 4 hours from San Francisco.
